Degradation: may alter one or more of the glove characteristics due to contact with chemical(s). Penetration: is the movement of a "chemical" and/or micro-organism through porous materials, seams, pinholes or other imperfections in a protective glove material at a non-molecular level.

Permeation: Breakthrough of a chemical through the material of the protective glove at the molecular level.

This information does not reflect the actual duration of protection in the workplace and the differentiation between mixtures and pure chemicals. The chemical resistance has been assessed under laboratory conditions from samples taken from the pain only and relates only to the chemical tested. It can be different if the chemical is used in a mixture. It is recommended to check that the gloves are suitable for the intended use because the conditions at the workplace may differ from the type test depending on temperature, abrasion and degradation.

When used, protective gloves may provide less resistance to the dangerous chemical due to changes in physical properties. Movements, snagging, nubbing, degradation caused by the chemical contact etc. may reduce the actual use time significantly. For corrosive chemicals, degradation can be the most important factor to consider in selection of chemical resistant gloves. Before usage, inspect the gloves for any defect or imperfections.

Donning: Wash and dry your hands completely before donning the gloves. Before use, inspect the gloves for any defects or imperfections and avoid wearing damaged, heavily solled, worn or ditry lalso internally glove of any substance, this could irritate and/or infect the skin and cause dermatitis. In this event, seek medical advice from the company doctor or consult a dermatologist. Ensure the gloves fit well. Doffing: When removing your gloves, place the fingeritis into the palm of the other glove. Pull the glove until almost off. Repeat on the other hand. With both gloves almost off shake both hands to remove the gloves fully. Make sure you don't get in touch with the outer surface of the glove when hazardous chemicals were handled. Only intended for single use!
